Regulation (UE) 2025/40

PPWR (Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation)

Version 07/2026

We hereby confirm that the packaging used for the products we market, is designed and manufactured in accordance with applicable regulatory requirements known as of the date of this document—specifically Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR), and more precisely the section regarding packaging design requirements (Articles 5 to 11):

- None of the following substances are intentionally added; consequently, expected concentrations are below applicable regulatory limits:
 - REACH: Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) < 0.1%
 - Heavy metals: Sum of concentrations of lead, mercury, cadmium, and hexavalent chromium < 100 mg/kg
 - PFAS: The packaging used is not intended for food contact and is not subject to the PFAS restriction. However, these substances are not expected to be present in the packaging used and levels should therefore remain below the threshold specified in Article 5, paragraph 5.
- The packaging supplied is recyclable via standard waste streams: cardboard, plastics, and wood.
- We already incorporate plastics containing recycled content into some of our packaging and are committed to increasing this proportion as soon as alternative packaging options become available on the market.
- The packaging supplied is selected and designed to protect the products we market, from internal storage at Saint Clair Textiles through to storage at our customers' facilities. It ensures product quality is maintained until the final destination. There is no unnecessary packaging.

Please note that our company does not conduct specific analyses; this declaration regarding substances is based on our current knowledge and on declarations received from our suppliers.
